Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 15 16 320.08053, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 17 320.08053 Requirements for requests to establish specialty license plates .--18 19 (1) An organization that seeks authorization to 20 establish a new specialty license plate for which an annual 21 use fee is to be charged must submit to the department: 22 (b) The results of a scientific sample survey of Florida motor vehicle owners that indicates at least 30,000 23 15,000 motor vehicle owners intend to purchase the proposed 24 25 specialty license plate at the increased cost. As used in this paragraph, the term "scientific sample survey" means 26 27 information that is gathered from a representative subset of 28 the population as a whole. The sample survey of registered motor vehicle owners must be performed independently of the 29 30 requesting organization by an organization that conducts 31 similar sample surveys as a normal course of business. 1 to conducting a sample survey for the purposes of this 2 section, a requesting organization must obtain a determination 3 from the department that the organization selected to conduct 4 the survey performs similar surveys as a normal course of 5 business and is independent of the requesting organization. б 7 The information required under this subsection must be submitted to the department at least 90 days before the 8 9 convening of the next regular session of the Legislature. 10 Section 2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (8) of section 320.08056, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 11 320.08056 Specialty license plates .--12 (8)(a) The department must discontinue the issuance of 13 14 an approved specialty license plate if: 15 1. Less than 16,000 8,000 plates, including annual renewals, are issued for that specialty license plate by the 16 17 end of the 3rd 5th year of sales. 2. Less than 16,000 8,000 plates, including annual 18 19 renewals, are issued for that specialty license plate during any subsequent 3-year <del>5-year</del> period. 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004. 21 22 23 24 SENATE SUMMARY Increases the number of persons who must indicate that they intend to purchase a specialty plate from 15,000 to 30,000 before such plate may be issued. Increases the number of plates that must be purchased to prevent a plate from being discontinued from 8,000 in a 5-year period to 16,000 in a 3-year period. 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 2
