(2) Before testifying before a Senate committee, a 18 19 person must complete an appearance card that includes, but need not be limited to, the individual's name and business 20 21 address; the agency that he or she represents, if any; and the 22 individual's signature. The card must contain a notice, printed in legible type located above the signature line, 23 which states that, by signing the card, the individual 24 25 acknowledges being under oath and subject to penalties for 26 perjury if he or she does not testify truthfully. 27 Section 2. SENATE SUMMARY Provides that an individual who appears before a committee of the Florida Senate is considered to be under oath and is subject to penalties for perjury if he or she testifies falsely. Requires the individual to sign an appearance card. Provides a presumption that, by signing the card, the individual acknowledges being under oath.
