(3) The department shall by rule adopt the blood-bornepathogen standard set forth in subpart Z of 29 C.F.R. part 1910,
as amended by Pub. L. No. 106-430, which shall apply to all
public sector employers, except public sector employers whose

compliance with the standard is required and regulated by federal law. The department shall compile and maintain a list of existing needleless systems and sharps with engineered sharps-injury protection which shall be available to assist employers, including the department and the Department of Corrections, in complying with the applicable requirements of the blood-borne-pathogen standard. The list may be developed from existing sources of information, including, without limitation, the United States Food and Drug Administration, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration, and the United States Department of Veterans Affairs.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.
