The Committee on Natural Resources recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 4, lines 15-28, delete those lines

and insert:

1. A quantification of the water supply needs for all existing and reasonably projected future uses within the planning horizon. The level-of-certainty planning goal associated with identifying the water supply needs of existing and future reasonable-beneficial uses shall be based upon meeting those needs for a 1-in-10-year drought event.

Population projections used for determining public water supply needs must be based upon the best available data. In determining the best available data, the district shall consider the University of Florida's Bureau of Economic and Business Research (BEBR) medium population projections and any population projection data and analysis submitted by a local government pursuant to the public workshop described in subsection (1) if the data and analysis support the local

1 government's comprehensive plan. Any adjustment of or
2 deviation from the BEBR projections must be fully described,
3 and the original BEBR data must be presented along with the
4 adjusted data.

5 2. A list of water source options ~~for water supply~~
6 ~~development~~, including traditional and alternative source
7 options ~~sources~~, from which local government, government-owned
8 and privately owned utilities, self-suppliers, and others may
9 choose, for water supply development, the total capacity of
10 which will, in conjunction with water conservation and other
11 demand management measures, exceed the needs identified in
12 subparagraph 1. The list of water source options for water
13 supply development must contain provisions that recognize that
14 alternative water source options for agricultural
15 self-suppliers are limited.
