The home addresses, telephone numbers, social 35 (11)36 security numbers, and photographs of employees of any licensed 37 facility who have a reasonable belief, based upon specific circumstances that have been reported in accordance with the 38 procedure adopted by the facility, that release of the 39 information may be used to threaten, intimidate, harass, inflict 40 41 violence upon, or defraud the employee or any member of the 42 employee's family; the home addresses, telephone numbers, social 43 security numbers, photographs, and places of employment of the 44 spouses and children of such persons; and the names and 45 locations of schools and day care facilities attended by the 46 children of such persons are confidential and exempt from s. 47 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. However, any state or federal agency that is authorized to have 48 49 access to such information by any provision of law shall be granted such access in the furtherance of its statutory duties, 50 51 notwithstanding the provisions of this subsection. The licensed 52 facility shall maintain the confidentiality of the personal information only if the employee submits a written request for 53 confidentiality to the licensed facility. This subsection is 54 55 subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in 56 accordance with s. 119.15, and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2004, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through 57 58 reenactment by the Legislature.
