 8 under the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995;
 9 clarifying the definition of "proprietary confidential
 10 business information"; providing an effective date.

 12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 14 Section 1. Section 365.174, Florida Statutes, is amended
 15 to read:

16 365.174 Proprietary confidential business information.--

17 (1) All proprietary confidential business information
 18 submitted by a provider to the board or the office, including
 19 the name and billing or service addresses of service
 20 subscribers, and trade secrets as defined by s. 812.081, is
 21 confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I
 22 of the State Constitution. Statistical abstracts of information
 23 collected by the board or the office may be released or
 24 published, but only in a manner that does not identify or allow
 25 identification of subscribers or their service numbers or of
 26 revenues attributable to any provider.

27 (2) As used in this section, the term "proprietary
 28 confidential business information" means customer lists,
 29 customer numbers, individual or aggregate customer data by

30 location, usage and capacity data, network facilities used to
31 serve subscribers ~~and other related information~~, technology
32 descriptions, technical information, or trade secrets, including
33 trade secrets as defined in s. 812.081, and the actual or
34 developmental costs of E911 systems that are developed,
35 produced, or received internally by a provider or by a
36 provider's employees, directors, officers, or agents.

37 ~~(3) This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset~~
38 ~~Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15, and shall stand~~
39 ~~repealed on October 1, 2004, unless reviewed and saved from~~
40 ~~repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.~~

41 Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2004.
