Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 1, line 24,

insert:

Section 2. Subsection (2) of section 290.00675,
Florida Statutes, is created to read:

290.00675 Amendment of certain enterprise zone
boundaries.--

(1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the
Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development may amend
the boundaries of an area designated as an enterprise zone in
a community having a population of 235,000 persons but less
than 260,000, so long as the area does not increase the
overall size of the zone by greater than 25 acres and the
increased area is contiguous to the existing enterprise zone.
The amendment must also be consistent with the limitations
imposed by s. 290.0055 upon establishment of the enterprise
zone.

1 (2) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the
2 Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development may approve
3 requests to amend the boundaries of an area designated as an
4 enterprise zone in a community having a population of 50,000
5 persons but less than 60,000, so long as the area does not
6 increase the overall size of the zone by greater than 400
7 acres and the increased area is contiguous to the existing
8 enterprise zone. The amendment must also be consistent with
9 the limitations imposed by s. 290.0055 upon establishment of
10 the enterprise zone. Such request must be submitted to the
11 office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development prior to
12 December 31, 2004.
