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The Conference Committee on HB 1865 offered the following:

Conference Committee Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 430.071, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

430.071 Respite for elders living in everyday families.--

(1) As used in this section, the term:

(c) "Stipend" means an allotment of funds to enable a diverse population of volunteers to provide services. The allotment of funds is for a maximum hourly rate that shall not exceed an amount equal to the federal minimum wage ~~period of service and is not an hourly wage.~~

Section 2. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 430.204, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

37 Section 4. Paragraphs (j) and (k) of subsection (1) of
38 section 430.502, Florida Statutes, are amended, and paragraph
39 (1) is added to said subsection, to read:

40 430.502 Alzheimer's disease; memory disorder clinics and
41 day care and respite care programs.--

42 (1) There is established:

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43 (j) A memory disorder clinic at Lee Memorial Hospital
44 created by chapter 63-1552, Laws of Florida, as amended; ~~and~~

45 (k) A memory disorder clinic at Sarasota Memorial Hospital
46 in Sarasota County; ~~and~~

47 (l) A memory disorder clinic at Morton Plant Hospital in
48 Pinellas County

50 for the purpose of conducting research and training in a
51 diagnostic and therapeutic setting for persons suffering from
52 Alzheimer's disease and related memory disorders. However,
53 memory disorder clinics funded as of June 30, 1995, shall not
54 receive decreased funding due solely to subsequent additions of
55 memory disorder clinics in this subsection.
