Florida Statutes, for residents or clients with a diagnosis of Alzheimer's disease or a related dementia may not be played with the personal funds of residents or clients and must be supervised by paid or volunteer staff. Prizes may be claimed only by residents or clients of these facilities or by guests who are residents or clients of other similarly licensed or authorized facilities. Net proceeds must be returned to players in the form of prizes after expenses for refreshments and bingo supplies are deducted. Any county or municipality that regulates the playing of bingo shall exempt bingo games conducted pursuant to this section from regulation and fees.
