5 catastrophically injured as defined in s. 121.091(4) in the

6 line of duty shall be considered totally and permanently

7 disabled and unable to render useful and efficient service as an

10 useful and efficient service as an officer. For purposes of this

15 Section 3. Effective July 1, 2004, in order to fund the
16 benefits provided in s. 121.091, Florida Statutes, as amended by
17 this act:

18 (1) The contribution rate that applies to the Special Risk
19 Class of the defined benefit program of the Florida Retirement
20 System shall be increased by 0.03 percentage points.

21 (2) The contribution rate that applies to the Special Risk
22 Administrative Support Class of the defined benefit program of
23 the Florida Retirement System shall be increased by 0.20
