Any 15 16 qualified beneficiary who has been accepted by and is enrolled 17 or is within 18 5 years of enrollment in an eligible independent college or university or state postsecondary 18 19 institution shall be entitled to exercise the complete benefits for which he or she has contracted. All other 20 contract holders shall receive a refund of the amount paid in 21 22 and an additional amount in the nature of interest at a rate that corresponds, at a minimum, to the prevailing interest 23 rates for savings accounts provided by banks and savings and 24 25 loan associations. 26 Section 2.
