409.819 Identification of low-income, uninsured
children; determination of eligibility for the Florida Kidcare
program; alternative health care information.--The Department
of Health shall develop a program, in conjunction with the
Department of Education, the Department of Children and Family
Services, the Agency for Health Care Administration, the
Florida Healthy Kids Corporation, local governments,
employers, and other stakeholders to identify low-income,
uninsured children and, to the extent possible and subject to
appropriation, refer them to the Department of Children and
Family Services for eligibility determination and provide
parents with information about choices of health benefits
