6. Chief Executive Officer of the Mayo Clinic,								
Jacksonville or his or her designee;								
7. Chief Executive Officer of the American Cancer								
Society, Florida Division or his or her designee;								
8. President of the American Cancer Society, Florida								
Division Board of Directors or his or her designee;								
9. President of the Florida Society of Clinical								
Oncology or his or her designee;								
10. President of the American College of Surgeons,								
Florida Chapter, or his or her designee;								
11. Chief Executive Officer of Enterprise Florida,								
Inc., or his or her designee;								
12. Five representatives from cancer programs approved								
by the American College of Surgeons. Three shall be appointed								
by the Governor, one shall be appointed by the Speaker of the								
House of Representatives, and one shall be appointed by the								
President of the Senate;								
13. One member of the House of Representatives, to be								
appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and								
14. One member of the Senate, to be appointed by the								
President of the Senate.								
(d) Appointments made by the Speaker of the House of								
Representatives and the President of the Senate pursuant to								
paragraph (c) shall be for 2-year terms, concurrent with the								
bienniums in which they serve as presiding officers.								
(e) Appointments made by the Governor pursuant to
