An act relating to service charges; amending ss. 319.32 and 320.04, F.S.; increasing certain service charges; providing for periodic adjustments based upon the Consumer Price Index; providing criteria; authorizing the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to make such adjustments by rule; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 319.32, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
  - 319.32 Fees; service charges; disposition.--
- (2)(a) There shall be a service charge of \$7 \$4.25 for each application which is handled in connection with the issuance, duplication, or transfer of any certificate of title. There shall be a service charge of \$1.25 for each application which is handled in connection with the recordation or notation of a lien on a motor vehicle or mobile home which is not in connection with the purchase of such vehicle.
- Section 2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 320.04, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (4) is added to said section, to read:
  - 320.04 Registration service charge.--
- (1)(a) There shall be a service charge of  $\frac{$3}{$2.50}$  for each application which is handled in connection with original issuance, duplicate issuance, or transfer of any license plate, mobile home sticker, or validation sticker or with transfer or duplicate issuance of any registration certificate. HB 0201 2004 also be a service charge of up to \$1 for the issuance of each license plate validation sticker, vessel decal, and mobile home sticker issued from an automated vending facility or printer dispenser machine which shall be payable to and retained by the department to provide for automated vending facilities or printer dispenser machines used to dispense such stickers and decals by each tax collector's or license tag agent's employee. (4) The service charges imposed pursuant to ss. 319.32(2)(a) and paragraph (1)(a) shall consist of the statutory amount adjusted to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index every 3 years after July 1, 2004. The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles shall by rule adjust the statutory amount based on increase or decrease in the Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers published by the United States Department of Labor. Adjustment shall be made July 1 of each third year after July 1, 2004, using the most recent month for
