Prior 8 to conducting a sample survey for the purposes of this 9 section, a requesting organization must obtain a determination from the department that the organization selected to conduct 10 11 the survey performs similar surveys as a normal course of business and is independent of the requesting organization. 12 13 The methodology, results, and any evaluation by the department of the scientific sample survey shall be validated by the 14 15 Auditor General as a condition precedent to submission of the 16 specialty license plate for approval by the Legislature. (c) An application fee, not to exceed \$60,000, to 17 defray the department's cost for reviewing the application and 18 19 developing the specialty license plate, if authorized. State 20 funds may not be used to pay the application fee, except for 21 collegiate specialty license plates authorized in s. 320.08058(3) and (13). The specialty license plate application 22 23 provisions of this act shall not apply to any organization 24 which has requested and received the required forms for 25 obtaining a specialty license plate authorization from the 26 Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, has opened a 27 bank account for the funds collected for the specialty license tag and has made deposits to such an account, and has obtained 28 signatures toward completing the requirements for the 29 30 specialty license tag.
