Up to 10 percent of the funds may be used for 20 continuing promotion and marketing of the license plate. 21 The remaining funds shall be used to conduct 4. scientific research and education on marine plants and animals 22 and coastal oceanography in state marine waters; to collect 23 24 and analyze long-term data sets on the state's critical marine 25 habitats; to determine changes in populations and communities of marine organisms and their impacts on the use of the 26 27 state's marine resources; to maintain reference collections of scientific specimens and photographic archives of the state's 28 29 marine plants and animals; and to conduct scientific 30 conferences of relevance to the state's marine resources and their management, utilization, and conservation. 31
