Section 410.706, Florida Statutes, is 13 14 created to read: 410.706 Elder Victims Trust Fund.--15 (1) There is created the Elder Victims Trust Fund 16 17 within the Department of Elderly Affairs. Funds shall be credited to the trust fund as provided by law to be used for 18 19 the investigation and prosecution of financial exploitation 20 against elderly persons and for education initiatives directed toward elderly persons, law enforcement officers, the judicial 21 22 system, social services professionals, and the public on financial exploitation of elderly persons. 23 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301, and 24 25 pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the 26 end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the 27 end of the year and shall be available for carrying out the 28 purposes of the trust fund. 29 (3) In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the 30 State Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated
