Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 15 16 322.09, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 322.09 Application of minors; responsibility for 17 negligence or misconduct of minor .--18 19 (1)(a) The application of any person under the age of 20 18 years for a driver's license must be signed and verified 21 before a person authorized to administer oaths by the father, 22 mother, or guardian, by a secondary guardian if the primary guardian withdraws consent or dies before the minor reaches 18 23 years of age, or, if there is no parent or guardian, by 24 25 another responsible adult who is willing to assume the 26 obligation imposed under this chapter upon a person signing 27 the application of a minor. This section does not apply to a 28 person under the age of 18 years who is emancipated by 29 marriage. 30 Section 2. Section 322.11, Florida Statutes, is 31 amended to read:

5	giving written notice to the minor, cancel such license and
6	may <del>shall</del> not issue a new license until <del>such time as</del> the new
7	application, <del>duly</del> signed and verified, is made as required by
8	this chapter. This provision <u>does</u> <del>shall</del> not apply <u>if</u> <del>in the</del>
9	event the minor has attained the age of 18 years.
10	Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.
