Section 86. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 490.014, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

490.014 Exemptions.--

(2) No person shall be required to be licensed or provisionally licensed under this chapter who:

(a) Is a salaried employee of a government agency or of a private provider contracting with the governmental agency for the performance of the same essential services previously provided by the governmental agency; developmental services program, mental health, alcohol, or drug abuse facility operating pursuant to chapter 393, chapter 394, or chapter 397; subsidized child care program, subsidized child care case management program, or child care resource and referral program operating pursuant to chapter 402; child-placing or child-caring agency licensed pursuant to chapter 409; domestic

1 violence center certified pursuant to chapter 39; accredited
 2 academic institution; or research institution, if such
 3 employee is performing duties for which he or she was trained
