- (a) The department shall develop a Florida Food Banks
 license plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida"
 must appear at the bottom of the plate, and the word "Imagine"
 must appear at the top of the plate.
- (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Florida Association of Food Banks, Inc., which may use up to 25 percent of the proceeds to market the organization's concept and the license plate. The remaining funds shall be used by the Florida Association of Food Banks, Inc., for programs to end hunger in this state.
- (c) An advisory board composed of a representative of each member of the Florida Association of Food Banks, Inc., shall review the distribution of funds by the association.
