17	condition deteriorated, and
18	WHEREAS, several hours later, Nicholas Patnode's parents
19	took him to Martin Memorial Medical Center, where a spinal tap
20	confirmed a diagnosis of bacterial meningitis, and Nicholas
21	Patnode was transferred to St. Mary's Hospital in critical
22	condition, and
23	WHEREAS, a decision was made to discontinue life support
24	due to irreversible brain damage, and Nicholas Patnode died on
25	January 10, 1998, and
26	WHEREAS, Nicholas Patnode is survived by his parents,
27	Cristina Alvarez and George Patnode, and

28	WHEREAS, the actions of the Martin County Health Department
29	demonstrated failure to adhere to a reasonable level of care of
30	Nicholas Patnode and resulted in his death, and
31	WHEREAS, after an unsuccessful attempt by Nicholas
32	Patnode's parents to settle this claim, it proceeded to
33	litigation, resulting in a judgment in favor of the parents in
34	the amount of \$2,600,000, NOW, THEREFORE,

36	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

38	Section 1. The facts stated in the preamble to this act
39	are found and declared to be true.
