

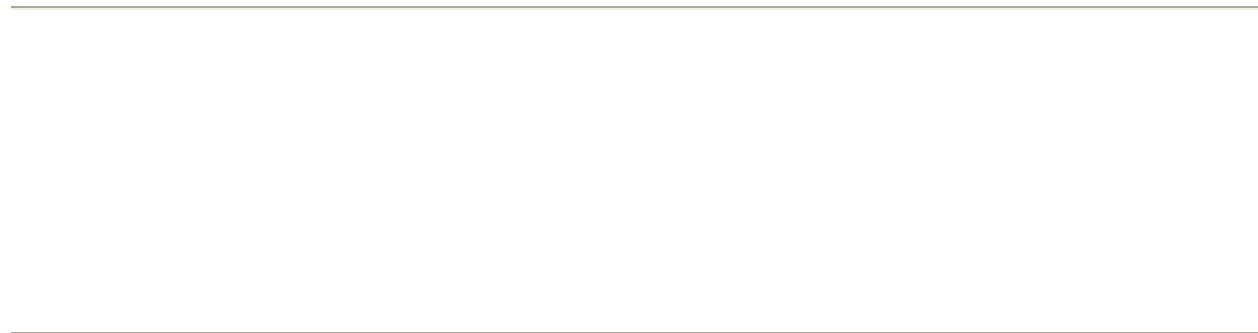

14 and in the state as a whole in the last preceding election in

15 which presidential electors were chosen.

16 (b) A revision or amendment to this constitution proposed
 17 by initiative may not have as its purpose any purpose that may
 18 be accomplished by general law and must amend or repeal, in
 19 whole or in part, an existing section or sections of this
 20 constitution on the same subject as the amendment or revision.
 21 For purposes of this subsection, a purpose that may not be
 22 accomplished by general law shall be limited to amending an
 23 existing limitation on governmental power set forth in this
 24 constitution, amending an existing basic or fundamental right of
 25 a citizen of this state as set forth in Article I, or amending
 26 the basic structure of state government as set forth in Article
 27 II, Article III, Article IV, or Article V. For purposes of this
 28 subsection, a purpose that may be accomplished by general law
 29 includes, but is not limited to, a purpose to direct the
 30 exercise of existing governmental power.
