This act shall be known by the popular name the "Ellwood Robinson 'Bob' Pipping, Jr., Memorial Act." 23 The purpose of this act is to create an 24 Section 2. 25 environment in which the people of Florida and its visitors 26 will be reminded of the accomplishments made by our military 27 veterans in past conflicts and the continuing sacrifices made 28 by those veterans and their families to protect the freedoms 29 we enjoy today. Section 3. The Department of Transportation is 30

authorized to enter into contract with any group or

organization for the installation and maintenance of monuments and memorials honoring our military veterans at highway rest areas around the state pursuant to the provisions of this section.

- (1) Proposals for contracts under this act must be approved by a committee composed of the Secretary of Transportation or the secretary's designee, the executive director of the Department of Veterans' Affairs or the executive director's designee, and three members of the Florida Commission on Veterans' Affairs appointed by the chair of the commission. Appointed members of the committee shall be appointed for terms of not longer than 2 years and may be reappointed to the committee. All appointed members' terms shall expire on January 31 of each even-numbered year.
- (2) Installations may consist of monuments, memorials, plaques, markers, or various retired military equipment and must honor the accomplishments of military veterans and the sacrifices made by them and their families.
- (3) The group or organization making the proposal shall be responsible for all costs of the monument and its installation.
- (4) The group or organization making the proposal shall be responsible for the cost of maintenance of the monument for a period of 10 years. The cost of maintenance shall be secured by sufficient funds provided by the group or organization making the proposal deposited into a maintenance account held by the Department of Transportation. In lieu of the maintenance account, the group or organization making the proposal may provide a bond securing the cost of removal of the monument should the group or organization making the

proposal fail to provide sufficient funds for maintenance for a period of 2 consecutive years. Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
