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20	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
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22	Section 1. This act shall be known by the popular name
23	the "Ellwood Robinson 'Bob' Pipping, Jr., Memorial Act."
24	Section 2. The purpose of this act is to create an
25	environment in which the people of Florida and its visitors
26	will be reminded of the accomplishments made by our military
27	veterans in past conflicts and the continuing sacrifices made
28	by those veterans and their families to protect the freedoms
29	we enjoy today.
30	Section 3. The Department of Transportation is
31	authorized to enter into contract with any group or

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organization for the installation and maintenance of monuments and memorials honoring our military veterans at highway rest areas around the state pursuant to the provisions of this section.

- approved by a committee composed of the Secretary of

 Transportation or the secretary's designee, the executive

 director of the Department of Veterans' Affairs or the

 executive director's designee, and three members of the

 Florida Commission on Veterans' Affairs appointed by the chair

 of the commission. Appointed members of the committee shall be

 appointed for terms of not longer than 2 years and may be

 reappointed to the committee. All appointed members' terms

 shall expire on January 31 of each even-numbered year.
- (2) Installations may consist of monuments, memorials, plaques, markers, or various retired military equipment and must honor the accomplishments of military veterans and the sacrifices made by them and their families.
- (3) The group or organization making the proposal shall be responsible for all costs of the monument and its installation.
- shall be responsible for the cost of maintenance of the monument. The cost of maintenance shall be secured by sufficient funds provided annually by the group or organization making the proposal deposited into a maintenance account held by the Department of Transportation. In addition, the group or organization making the proposal will provide a 10 year bond securing the cost of removal of the monument, and any modifications made to the site as part of the placement of the monument, for use should the group or organization making

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the proposal fail to provide sufficient funds for maintenance
   for a period of 2 consecutive years. Prior to expiration, the
    bond shall be renewed for another 10 year period if the

    memorial is to remain in place.
