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A bill to be entitled
An act relating to public employees; requiring
an employee who is a member of the Legislature
to take unpaid leave for time away from
employment while on legislative business;
defining the term "public employee"; providing
an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Public employees required to take unpaid
leave while on legislative business.--A public employee who is
a member of the Legislature must take unpaid administrative
leave for any period of time away from his or her place of
employment due to legislative duties and responsibilities. As
used in this section, the term "public employee" means an
employee of this state or of a regional, local, or municipal
government entity of this state, including all political
subdivisions of this state and any public school, community
college, or state university.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.

SENATE SUMMARY

Requires a public employee who is a member of the
Legislature to take unpaid leave for the time spent away
from employment while on legislative business.
