A bill to be entitled
An act relating to traffic; amending s. 316.006, F.S.;
providing for jurisdiction and authority of municipalities
to regulate commercial vehicle traffic; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) is added to subsection (2) of
section 316.006, Florida Statutes, to read:

316.006 Jurisdiction.--Jurisdiction to control traffic is
vested as follows:

(2) MUNICIPALITIES.--

(c) Municipalities shall have jurisdiction and authority
to regulate and restrict commercial vehicle traffic over all
streets and highways located within their boundaries by granting
permits, franchises, and licenses or by otherwise exercising
such authority. The purpose of this paragraph is to reinforce
the long-standing policy of this state.

This subsection shall not limit those counties which have the
charter powers to provide and regulate arterial, toll, and other
roads, bridges, tunnels, and related facilities from the proper
exercise of those powers by the placement and maintenance of
traffic control devices which conform to the manual and
specifications of the Department of Transportation on streets
and highways located within municipal boundaries.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
