An act relating to license plates; amending ss. 320.08056 and 320.08058, F.S.; creating a Family First license plate; providing for the distribution of annual use fees received from the sale of such plates; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (ss) is added to subsection (4) of section 320.08056 , Florida Statutes, to read:
320.08056 Specialty license plates.--
(4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be collected for the appropriate specialty license plates: (ss) Family First license plate, \$25. Section 2. Subsection (45) is added to section 320.08058 , Florida Statutes, to read:
320.08058 Specialty license plates.-(45) FAMILY FIRST LICENSE PLATES.--
(a) The department shall develop a Family First license plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Family First" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
(b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to Family First to fund programs, projects, seminars, events, and family resources that promote principles for building marriages, guiding parents, and raising children. Family First shall retain all revenues from the sale of the plate until its startup costs for developing and establishing the plate have been recovered.
