Section 316.2015, Florida Statutes, is 16 17 amended to read: 18 316.2015 Unlawful for person to ride on exterior of 19 vehicle.--20 (1)It is unlawful for any operator of a passenger 21 vehicle to permit any person to ride on the bumper, radiator, 22 fender, hood, top, trunk, or running board of such vehicle 23 when operated upon any street or highway which is maintained 24 by the state, county, or municipality. However, the operator 25 of any vehicle shall not be in violation of this section when 26 such operator permits any person to occupy seats securely 27 affixed to the exterior of such vehicle. Any person who 28 violates the provisions of this subsection shall be cited for a moving violation, punishable as provided in chapter 318. 29 30 (2) A No person may not shall ride on any vehicle upon 31 any portion thereof not designed or intended for the use of 1

1 passengers. This provision does shall not apply to an employee of a fire department, a governmentally operated solid waste 2 3 disposal department, or a waste disposal service operating pursuant to a contract with a governmental entity or to a 4 5 volunteer firefighter engaged in the necessary discharge of a б duty, and does not apply to a person who is being transported 7 in response to an emergency by a public agency or pursuant to 8 the direction or authority of a public agency or to a person 9 or persons riding within truck bodies in space intended for 10 merchandise. A minor child 16 years of age or younger may not 11 ride upon the public roads of the state within the body of an open pickup truck or flatbed truck unless the minor is 12 restrained within the back of a truck that has been modified 13 to include secure seating and safety restraints that would 14 prevent the minor from being thrown, falling, or jumping from 15 the truck. This subsection is inapplicable in a medical 16 17 emergency if the child is accompanied within the truck by an adult and is inapplicable when the truck is being operated 18 19 upon a farm or off the public roads of the state. Any person 20 who violates the provisions of this subsection shall be cited for a nonmoving violation, punishable as provided in chapter 21 318. 22 This section does shall not apply to a performer 23 (3) 24 engaged in a professional exhibition or person participating 25 in an exhibition or parade, or a any such person preparing to participate in such exhibitions or parades. 26 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004. б SENATE SUMMARY Prohibits certain persons from riding on or in certain areas of motor vehicles not designated for passengers. Provides penalties. Authorizes certain local governments to exempt themselves from such prohibitions. (See bill for details.)
