If such tests are deemed to be 22 valid and reliable measures, the commissioner shall approve 23 the use of such tests as alternative alternate assessments to the grade 10 FCAT for the 2002-2003 school year. Students who 24 25 attain scores that equate to the passing scores on the grade 10 FCAT for purposes of high school graduation on any of the 26 27 approved alternative assessments shall satisfy the assessment 28 requirement for a standard high school diploma as provided in s. 1003.43(5)(a) for the 2002-2003 school year graduating 29 30 class. Prior to the application of these alternative 31

assessments in subsequent school years, The Legislature shall review the continued use of these alternative tests. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. б SENATE SUMMARY With respect to the student assessment program for public schools, deletes dates that limit to the 2002-2003 school year and the 2002-2003 graduating class the applicability of the use of alternative assessments in lieu of the grade 10 FCAT. Deletes a provision prohibiting the use of alternative tests after the 2002-2003 school year unless the Legislature has reviewed those assessments.
