A joint resolution proposing an amendmen

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to Section 8 of Article I of the State Constitution relating to an exception to the mandatory three-day waiting period associated with the purchase and delivery of handguns for law enforcement officers who are exempt from the weapons and firearms licensing and penal provisions of law.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 That the following amendment to Section 8 of Article I of the State Constitution is agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next general election or at an earlier special session specifically authorized by law for that purpose:

ARTICLE I DECLARATION OF RIGHTS

SECTION 8. Right to bear arms.--

- (a) The right of the people to keep and bear arms in defense of themselves and of the lawful authority of the state shall not be infringed, except that the manner of bearing arms may be regulated by law.

(b) There shall be a mandatory period of three days, excluding weekends and legal holidays, between the purchase and delivery at retail of any handgun. For the purposes of this section, "purchase" means the transfer of money or other valuable consideration to the retailer, and "handgun" means a firearm capable of being carried and used by one hand, such as a pistol or revolver. Holders of a concealed weapon permit and

law enforcement officers who are exempt from weapons and firearms licensing and penal provisions as prescribed in Florida law shall not be subject to the provisions of this paragraph.

- (c) The legislature shall enact legislation implementing subsection (b) of this section, effective no later than December 31, 1991, which shall provide that anyone violating the provisions of subsection (b) shall be guilty of a felony.
- (d) This restriction shall not apply to a trade in of another handgun.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be placed on the ballot:

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

ARTICLE I, SECTION 8

WAITING PERIOD FOR HANDGUN PURCHASES; EXCEPTION FOR CERTAIN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.—Proposing an amendment to the State Constitution to provide an exception to the mandatory three-day waiting period associated with the purchase and delivery of handguns for law enforcement officers who are otherwise exempt from the weapons and firearms licensing and penal provisions of Florida law.
