**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 30, between lines 19 and 20

insert:

(3) Notwithstanding s. 402.265 and s. 411.01(10), the  
Department of Education, the Agency for Workforce Innovation,  
the Department of Children and Family Services, and the  
regional child development boards may enter into interagency  
agreements that provide for the integration of, and shall  
provide interagency access among these agencies to, databases  
containing records, data, or other information relating to the  
following:

(a) Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program;

(b) School readiness programs; or

(c) Licensure or registration, inspection, and  
disciplinary actions of child care facilities, family day care  
homes, and large family child care homes.

1 These databases may comprise individual records of students,  
2 child development providers, and public schools in the  
3 Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program and individual  
4 records of students and providers in school readiness  
5 programs. The agencies must protect the confidentiality of  
6 school readiness records in accordance with s. 411.011. These  
7 databases may also include the statewide child care resource  
8 and referral network established under s. 402.27 and each  
9 regional child development board's single point of entry  
10 established under s. 411.01.
