A bill to be entitled 2 An act relating to Broward County; providing for extending the corporate limits of the Town 3 of Davie, the City of Fort Lauderdale, or the 4 5 City of Plantation; providing for annexation of 6 the unincorporated area known as Broadview 7 Park; providing for an election; providing for an effective date of annexation; providing for 8 an interlocal agreement; providing for a 9 10 continuation of certain Broward County regulations; providing for transfer of public 11 12 roads and rights-of-way; providing an effective 13 date. 14 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 15 16 17 Section 1. No later than July 1, 2004, the governing 18 body of the municipalities of the Town of Davie, the City of Fort Lauderdale, and the City of Plantation, after having 19 considered the effects of annexation on the residents of both 20 21 the "Broadview Park Area," as hereinafter described, and on the respective municipality, shall inform the Broward County 22 23 Legislative Delegation and the Broward County Board of County Commissioners of their desire to appear on the ballot as 2.4 provided for in this act. 25 Section 2. The Broward County Board of County 26 27 Commissioners shall schedule an election in accordance with 2.8 the provisions of the law relating to elections currently in force in Broward County on November 2, 2004. The subject of 29 said election shall be the annexation of the Broadview Park 30 Area. Only registered voters residing in the Broadview Park

1	Area as described in section 3 may vote in said election. On
2	the ballot provided for in this section shall appear the name
3	of each municipality which shall have informed the Broward
4	County Legislative Delegation that it desires to appear on the
5	ballot as provided for in section 1. The voters residing in
6	the Broadview Park Area shall, by plurality vote of the voters
7	participating in the election, choose to be annexed by one
8	municipality effective September 15, 2005. In the event only
9	one municipality shall have informed the Broward County
10	Legislative Delegation that it desires to appear on the ballot
11	as provided for in section 1, the voters residing in the
12	Broadview Park Area shall, by majority vote of the voters
13	participating in the election, choose whether to be annexed by
14	that city on September 15, 2005, or September 15, 2006. A mail
15	ballot shall not be used in this election. However, voters may
16	vote by absentee ballot as provided by law.
17	Section 3. The "Broadview Park Area" is described as:
18	
19	That portion of Sections 13, 14, 23 and 24,
20	Township 50 South, Range 41 East and Section
21	18, Township 50 South, Range 42 East, Broward
22	County, Florida, described as follows:
23	
24	Beginning at a point on the boundary of the
25	City of Plantation established by Chapter
26	68-101 Laws of Florida, being the Southeast
27	corner of Tract 1, Tier 24, according to
28	Newman's Survey of Section 14, Township 50
29	South, Range 41 East, as recorded in Plat Book
30	2, Page 26, Public Records of Dade County,
31	Florida;

2	thence continuing along the said boundary of
3	the City of Plantation the following 6 courses;
4	
5	thence Northeasterly along the East line of
6	said Tier 24, to the North line of said Section
7	<u>13;</u>
8	
9	thence East along the said North line of
10	Section 13 to a point of intersection with the
11	Northerly extension of the Westerly line of
12	Block 3, as shown by the plat of LAUDERDALE
13	HIGHLANDS as recorded in Plat Book 12, at Page
14	37, Public Records of Broward County, Florida;
15	
16	thence Southwesterly along the Westerly line of
17	said Block 3 and its Northerly extension
18	thereof, to the Southwesterly corner of Lot 11
19	of said Block 3;
20	
21	thence Easterly along the Southerly line of
22	said Lot 11 and its Easterly extension thereof,
23	to a point of intersection with the Easterly
24	right-of-way line of Highland Avenue, as shown
25	by said plat of LAUDERDALE HIGHLANDS;
26	
27	thence Southwesterly along the Easterly
28	right-of-way line of said Highland Avenue to a
29	point of intersection with the South line of
30	Block 1, as shown by said plat of LAUDERDALE
31	HIGHLANDS;

2	thence Easterly along the South line of said
3	Block 1 and its Easterly extension thereof to a
4	point of intersection with the East
5	right-of-way line of State Road No. 7, as
6	described in City of Fort Lauderdale annexing
7	Resolution No. 8519;
8	
9	thence Southerly along the said east
10	right-of-way line to the North right-of-way
11	line of Riverland Road and the boundary of the
12	Town of Davie as described in Chapter 84-420,
13	Laws of Florida;
14	
15	thence continuing along said boundary of the
16	Town of Davie the following 10 courses;
17	
18	thence Westerly along the Westerly prolongation
19	of the said North right-of-way line to the West
20	right-of-way line of State Road No. 7;
21	
22	thence Southerly along said West right-of-way
23	line to a point of intersection with a line 300
24	feet North of the Southerly line of Tract 2,
25	Tier 4, of said Newman's Survey, as measured
26	along the said Westerly right-of-way line;
27	
28	thence Northwesterly to a point on the Easterly
29	right-of-way line of Southwest 41st Avenue,
30	being 298.34 feet Northerly from the Southwest
31	corner of said Tract 2, Tier 4;

2	thence Westerly to a point of intersection of
3	the West right-of-way line of Southwest 41st
4	Avenue with the North line of said Section 24;
5	
6	thence Southwesterly along the said West
7	right-of-way line to the centerline of North
8	New River Canal;
9	
10	thence Southeasterly along said centerline to
11	the Westerly right-of-way line of State Road
12	No. 7;
13	
14	thence Southwesterly along said West
15	right-of-line to the South bank of the North
16	New River Canal;
17	
18	thence Northwesterly along said South bank to
19	the Northerly extension of the West line of the
20	East One-Half of Tract 1, Tier 7 of said
21	Newman's Survey;
22	
23	thence Southwesterly along said Northerly
24	extension to the Northwest corner of the said
25	East One-Half of Tract 1, Tier 7, also being on
26	the South right-of-way line of North New River
27	<u>Canal;</u>
28	
29	thence Northwesterly along the said Southerly
30	right-of-way line to the Easterly line of Tier
31	21 of said Newman's Survey;

2	thence Northwesterly, continuing on the
3	boundary of the Town of Davie, along the said
4	Southerly right-of-way line to the intersection
5	with the Southwesterly extension of the East
6	line of the aforesaid Tract 1, Tier 24;
7	
8	thence Northeasterly along said Southwesterly
9	extension to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
10	
11	Section 4. If the unincorporated area described in
12	section 3 is annexed by either the Town of Davie or the City
13	of Plantation, the additional area described in section 5
14	shall be included in the annexation.
15	Section 5. The additional area shall be described as:
16	
17	That portion of Sections 7, 8, 14, 15, 16 and
18	17, Township 50 South, Range 41 East and
19	Sections 2, 11 and 12, Township 50 South, Range
20	40 East, Broward County, Florida, described as
21	<u>follows:</u>
22	
23	Beginning at a point on the boundary of the
24	City of Plantation established by Chapter
25	68-101, Laws of Florida, being the Southeast
26	corner of Tract 1, Tier 24, according to
27	Newman's Survey of Section 14, Township 50
28	South, Range 41 East, as recorded in Plat Book
29	2, Page 26, Public Records of Dade County,
30	<u>Florida;</u>
31	

1	thence Northwesterly along the North right of
2	way line of the North New River Canal and along
3	the boundary of the City of Plantation
4	established by said Chapter 68-101 and by
5	Ordinance 1008, Ordinance 568, and Ordinance
6	543, all as adopted by the City of Plantation,
7	to the intersection with the West line of said
8	Section 2;
9	
10	thence Southerly along the said West line to
11	the South right of way line of the North New
12	River Canal, being a point on the boundary of
13	the Town of Davie established by Chapter
14	84-420, Laws of Florida;
15	
16	thence Southeasterly along the said South right
17	of way line and along the boundary of the Town
18	of Davie established by said Chapter 84-420 and
19	by Ordinance 85-97, adopted by the Town of
20	Davie, to the intersection with the
21	Southwesterly extension of the East line of
22	Tier 24 of said Newman's Survey;
23	
24	thence Northeasterly along the said
25	Southwesterly extension to the POINT OF
26	BEGINNING.
27	
28	Section 6. An interlocal agreement shall be developed
29	between the governing bodies of Broward County and the
30	annexing municipality and executed prior to the effective date
31	of the annexation. The agreement shall address infrastructure

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improvement programs and include a financially feasible plan 2 for transitioning county services, buildings, infrastructure, 3 waterways, and employees. 4 Section 7. Upon annexation into the municipality, the following shall govern the areas described in sections 3 and 5 6 5: 7 (1) The present land use designations and zoning districts provided for under the Broward County Comprehensive 8 9 Plan and Code of Ordinances of Broward County shall remain the 10 law governing the Broadview Park Area, notwithstanding the fact that the Broadview Park Area is now a part of a 11 12 municipality. 13 (2) Any change of zoning districts or land use designations may only be accomplished by enactment of the vote 14 of the majority of the full governing body of the municipality 15 plus one. 16 17 (3) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2), any use, 18 building, or structure that is legally in existence at the time that the Broadview Park Area becomes a part of the 19 municipality shall not be made a prohibited use by the 2.0 21 municipality, on the property of said use, for as long as the use shall continue, and not be voluntarily abandoned. 2.2 23 Section 8. Subsequent to the effective date of this act, no change in land use designation or zoning shall be 2.4 25 effective within the limits of the lands subject to annexation herein until the Broadview Park Area has been annexed into the 26 2.7 municipality; no annexation within the Broadview Park Area by 2.8 any municipality shall occur during the time period between the effective date of this act and the effective date of the 29 30 annexation.

1	Section 9. Subsequent to the effective date of the
2	annexation, any resident in the area to be annexed by this act
3	into the Town of Davie, the City of Fort Lauderdale, or the
4	City of Plantation shall be deemed to have met any residency
5	requirements for candidacy for municipal office.
6	Section 10. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed
7	to affect or abrogate the rights of parties to any contracts,
8	whether the same be between Broward County and a third party
9	or between nongovernmental entities, which contracts are in
10	effect prior to the effective date of the annexation.
11	Section 11. All public roads and the public
12	rights-of-way associated therewith, on the Broward County Road
13	System, including bridge structures 868303, 864024, 864022,
14	864096, and 864097, lying within the limits of the lands
15	subject to annexation herein, as described in either section 3
16	or section 5, are transferred from Broward County jurisdiction
17	to the jurisdiction of the annexing municipality, except for
18	those portions of Hiatus Road, Nob Hill Road, Pine Island
19	Road, and Davie Boulevard and that portion of Peters Road west
20	of the Peters Road/Davie Boulevard intersection lying within
21	the limits of the annexation area. All rights, title,
22	interests, and responsibilities for any transferred roads,
23	including, but not limited to, the ownership, operation,
24	maintenance, planning, design, and construction of said roads,
25	and to the rights-of-way associated therewith, shall transfer
26	from Broward County jurisdiction and ownership to the
27	jurisdiction and ownership of the annexing municipality upon
28	the effective date of the annexation.
29	Section 12. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
30	law.
