A memorial to the Congress of the United

States, urging Congress to enact H.R. 720, the

Sales Tax Equity Act of 2003.

WHEREAS, a personal-income tax penalizes hard work, savings, investment, and job growth, unlike a consumption tax, and

WHEREAS, 42 states impose a state income tax, some of which are quite onerous and prompt many residents of those state to flee to the State of Florida, which is one of 8 states that do not impose such a tax, and

WHEREAS, the tax laws of the Federal Government currently allow a taxpayer to deduct from his or her federal tax liability the amount paid in state income taxes, but those laws do not allow Floridians to deduct any of the sales taxes that they have paid, and

WHEREAS, restoring needed fairness in the deductibility of state taxes by allowing a fair share of sales taxes to be deducted from the federal tax liability would relieve stress on the family budgets of the people of Florida, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the Congress of the United States is requested to enact H.R. 720, the Sales Tax Equity Act of 2003, which would provide a sales-tax deduction for federal taxpayers who reside in states that do not impose a state income tax.
