2 An act relating to the Florida Kidcare program; creating 3 s. 409.8141, F.S.; providing that an uninsured parent, quardian, or relative caretaker of a child enrolled in the 4 5 Florida Kidcare program is eligible for coverage under the б program, subject to certain limitations; requiring 7 separate premiums or cost-sharing requirements for the 8 parent, quardian, or relative caretaker; providing that 9 nonpayment of premiums or cost-sharing requirements for an adult is not grounds for disenrolling a child in that 10 11 family from the program; providing for coverage of a parent, guardian, or relative caretaker whose income is 12 13 above a specified level if the adult pays the full cost of 14 the premium, including administrative costs; providing 15 that the eligibility for coverage provided by the act is not an entitlement; authorizing the Agency for Health Care 16 17 Administration and the board of directors of the Florida 18 Healthy Kids Corporation to limit enrollment under the act; exempting the adults enrolled under the act from the 19 20 enrollment limitations of the Florida Kidcare program; providing an effective date. 21
