1 A bill to be entitled

An act relating to nursing home employer health insurance; authorizing nursing home employers to contract with the Department of Management Services to purchase coverage in the state group health insurance plan for certain persons; providing participation requirements; requiring the department to maintain certain records; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. <u>Nursing home employer health insurance; state</u> group health insurance plan.--

(1) A nursing home employer which participates in the

Medicaid program may contract with the Department of Management

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Services to purchase coverage in the state group health insurance plan for the employer and the employer's eligible employees and dependants of such employees. Each nursing home employer who participates in the state group health insurance plan shall collect the employee contribution, in the form of a

payroll deduction or other remuneration, from each qualified

employee as required by the department by rule. The employer shall also make the required contributions that will be apple

shall also make the required contributions that will be applied toward the cost of the monthly premiums and shall pay an annual

25 administrative fee of not less than \$5 per enrollee per month,

as determined by the department. The employee's proportionate

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contribution to the monthly premium shall not be in excess of that charged to state employees enrolled in the state group

29 health insurance plan.

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(2) The Department of Management Services shall maintain a separate accounting for all records of nursing home employers who elect coverage under this section, including all statistical information necessary for making actuarial assumptions for the group.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.
