An act relating to homeowner's insurance;
creating s. 627.70115, F.S.; requiring an
insurer to give notice before canceling a
homeowner's insurance policy; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 627.70115, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

627.70115 Homeowner's insurance; notification of
cancellation.--With respect to any homeowner's insurance
policy issued or renewed on or after July 1, 2004, such policy
may not be canceled unless the insurer gives the insured at
least 6 months' notice of its intent to do so.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.

SENATE SUMMARY

Requires the insurer to give the insured at least 6
months' notice of cancellation of a homeowner's insurance
policy.
