B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

Currently, the Escambia County Utilities Authority (ECUA) is an independent special district originally established in 1981 by an Act of the Florida Legislature. The ECUA is a local governmental entity consisting of a five-member Board elected from one of the five County electoral districts. The ECUA has the authority to own, manage, finance, promote, improve, and expand the water systems of the City of Pensacola and Escambia County, FL.

This bill changes the name of the ECUA to, "Emerald Coast Utilities Authority." The new title may help the general public decipher the ECUA's independence from official Escambia County services and operations.
