Section 316.570, Florida Statutes, is created to read: 15 316.570 Rebuilt, modified, or retrofitted dump 16 17 trucks.--(1) As used in this section, the term: 18 19 (a) "Dump truck" means any motor vehicle with a net 20 weight of more than 5,000 pounds which is registered on the 21 basis of gross vehicle weight in accordance with s. 320.08(4) 22 and is properly equipped with a container used for transporting and dumping various materials, resources, or 23 24 items. 25 (b) "Person" means any form of corporation, limited 26 liability company, partnership, association, cooperative, joint venture, business trust, sole proprietorship, or 27 28 self-employed person who conducts business in this state. 29 (2) Any person engaged in retrofitting, rebuilding, or 30 modifying commercial trucks, truck tractors, or heavy trucks, as defined in s. 320.01, into dump trucks must have evidence

1 that he or she is insured under a commercial liability insurance policy with limits of at least \$1 million per 2 3 accident and \$1 million annual aggregate. Evidence of such 4 insurance policy must be available at all reasonable hours for 5 inspection by any law enforcement officer. 6 (3) Any person engaged in retrofitting, rebuilding, or 7 modifying commercial trucks, truck tractors, or heavy trucks, as defined in s. 320.01, into dump trucks must ensure that 8 each such retrofitted, rebuilt, or modified dump truck 9 10 complies with all federal safety standards provided in 49 11 C.F.R. s. 393. 12 (4) Any person who violates subsection (2) or subsection (3) commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, 13 14 punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. Any person 15 who violates subsection (2) or subsection (3) a second time commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as 16 provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. Any person who violates 17 18 subsection (2) or subsection (3) a third or subsequent time 19 commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. 20 Section 2.
