I of the State Constitution. 5 (11) The home addresses, telephone numbers, social 6 security numbers, and photographs of employees of any licensed 7 facility who have a reasonable belief that release of the information may be used to threaten, intimidate, harass, 9 inflict violence upon, or defraud the employee or any member 10 of the employee's family; the home addresses, telephone 11 numbers, social security numbers, photographs, and places of employment of the spouses and children of such persons; and 12 13 the names and locations of schools and day care facilities attended by the children of such persons are confidential and 14 exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State 15 Constitution.
