11-119A-04 A bill to be entitled 1 2 An act relating to dental licensure; amending 3 s. 466.006, F.S.; allowing certain dental 4 students to take the examinations required to 5 practice dentistry in this state under 6 specified conditions; providing a prerequisite 7 to licensure of such students; creating s. 466.0065, F.S.; allowing certain dental 8 9 students to take regional licensure examinations under specified conditions; 10 restricting the applicability of examination 11 12 results to licensing in other jurisdictions; requiring approval by the Board of Dentistry 13 and providing prerequisites to such approval; 14 providing an effective date. 15 16 17 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 18 19 Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 466.006, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 20 466.006 Examination of dentists.--21 22 (2) An applicant shall be entitled to take the 23 examinations required in this section to practice dentistry in 24 this state if the applicant: 25 (a) Is 18 years of age or older. (b)1. Is a graduate of a dental school accredited by 26 27 the Commission on Accreditation of the American Dental 28 Association or its successor agency, if any, or any other 29 nationally recognized accrediting agency; or. 30 2. Is a dental student in the final year of a program at such an accredited school who has completed all the 31 1

1 coursework necessary to prepare the student to perform the clinical and diagnostic procedures required to pass the 2 3 examinations. With respect to a dental student in the final year of a program at a dental school, a passing score on the 4 5 examinations is valid for 180 days after the date the б examinations were completed. A dental school student who takes 7 the licensure examinations during the student's final year of 8 an approved dental school must have graduated before being certified for licensure pursuant to s. 466.011. 9 10 (c) Has successfully completed the National Board of 11 Dental Examiners dental examination within 10 years of the date of application. 12 Section 2. Section 466.0065, Florida Statutes, is 13 created to read: 14 466.0065 Regional licensure examinations.--15 (1) It is the intent of the Legislature that schools 16 of dentistry be allowed to offer regional licensure 17 examinations to dental students who are in the final year of a 18 19 program at an approved dental school for the sole purpose of facilitating the student's licensing in other jurisdictions. 20 This section does not allow a person to be licensed as a 21 dentist in this state without taking the examinations as set 22 forth in s. 466.006, nor does this section mean that regional 23 24 examinations administered under this section may be 25 substituted for complying with testing requirements under s. 466.006. 26 27 (2) Each school of dentistry in this state which is 28 accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of the American 29 Dental Association or its successor agency may, upon written 30 approval by the Board of Dentistry, offer regional licensure 31 examinations only to dental students in the final year of a 2

1 program at an approved dental school, if the board has approved the hosting school's written plan to comply with the 2 3 following conditions: The examining body must be a member of the 4 (a) 5 American Association of Dental Examiners. 6 (b) The student must have successfully completed parts 7 I and II of the National Board of Dental Examiners examination 8 within 2 years before taking the regional examination. 9 (C) The student must possess medical malpractice 10 insurance in amounts that the board determines to be 11 sufficient to cover any reasonably forseeable incident of harm to a patient during the clinical portion of the regional 12 13 examination. (d) At least one of the examination monitors must be a 14 dentist licensed in this state who has completed all necessary 15 standardization exercises required by the regional examination 16 body. 17 18 (e) Adequate arrangements must be made, when 19 necessary, for patients who require followup care as a result of procedures performed during the clinical portion of the 20 21 regional examination. 22 The board chair or the chair's designee must be (f) allowed to observe testing while it is in progress. 23 24 (g) Each student, upon applying to take the regional 25 examination, must receive written disclosure in at least 26 12-point boldface type which states: "This examination does 27 not meet the licensure requirements of chapter 466, Florida Statutes, for licensure in the State of Florida. Persons 28 29 wishing to practice dentistry in Florida must pass the Florida 30 licensure examinations. For more information on Florida's 31

1 licensure examination procedures, please contact the Florida 2 Board of Dentistry." 3 (h) The student must be enrolled as a dental student 4 in the student's final year of a program at an approved dental 5 school that is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation б of the American Dental Association or its successor agency. 7 The student must have completed all the coursework (i) 8 necessary to prepare the student to perform all clinical and 9 diagnostic procedures required to pass the regional examination. 10 11 (j) The student's academic record must not include any evidence suggesting that the student poses an unreasonable 12 risk to any live patients who are required for the clinical 13 14 portion of the regional examination. In order to protect the health and safety of the public, the board may request 15 additional information and documents pertaining to the 16 17 candidate's mental and physical health in order to fully assess the candidate's fitness to engage in exercises 18 19 involving a live patient. (3) A student who takes the examination pursuant to 20 this section, a dental school that submits a plan pursuant to 21 this section, or a regional examination body that a dental 22 school proposes to host under this section does not have 23 24 standing to assert that a state agency has taken action for 25 which a hearing may be sought under ss. 120.569 and 120.57. Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004. 26 27 28 29 30 31
