**Senate Amendment**

On page 1, line 19, through  
page 2, line 3, delete those lines

and insert: to acquire, possess and protect property; except  
that the ownership, inheritance, disposition and possession of  
real property by terrorists or persons affiliated with  
terrorism, as defined by general law, ~~aliens ineligible for~~  
citizenship may be regulated or prohibited by law. No person  
shall be deprived of any right because of race, religion,  
national origin, or physical disability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be  
placed on the ballot:
