Basic rights. -- All natural persons, female and male alike, are equal before the law and have inalienable 16 rights, among which are the right to enjoy and defend life and 17 18 liberty, to pursue happiness, to be rewarded for industry, and to acquire, possess and protect property; except that the 19 ownership, inheritance, disposition and possession of real 20 property by terrorists or persons affiliated with terrorism, 21 22 as defined by general law, aliens ineligible for citizenship 23 may be regulated or prohibited by law.
