Funds 21 credited to the trust fund shall consist of moneys 22 appropriated by the Legislature for the purpose of awarding 23 matching grants to private sector employers that provide wages to employees serving in the United States Armed Forces 24 25 Reserves or the Florida National Guard while those employees 26 are on federal active duty. 27 (2) In accordance with Section 19(f)(2) of Article III 28 of the State Constitution, the trust fund shall be terminated 29 on July 1, 2008, unless terminated sooner. Before its 30 scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in section 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes. 31 1
