(2) The sale of real property which includes a 18 19 consumptive use permit issued for that property does not 20 constitute a sale or transfer of the permit or a new use under 21 this section. 22 (3) An interdistrict transfer of groundwater authorized in s. 373.2295 does not constitute a transfer or 23 24 new use under this section. 25 Section 2.
