A bill to be entitled
An act relating to water resources; creating s.
373.2315, F.S.; providing for restrictions on
the sale or transfer of consumptive use permits
or permitted quantities of groundwater;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 373.2315, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

373.2315 Restrictions on the sale or transfer of a
consumptive use permit or permitted quantities; exceptions.--

(1) The sale or transfer of a consumptive use permit
or a permitted quantity by a permit holder is a new use, and
the buyer or transferee must apply for a new consumptive use
permit.

(2) The sale of real property which includes a
consumptive use permit issued for that property does not
constitute a sale or transfer of the permit or a new use under
this section.

(3) An interdistrict transfer of groundwater
authorized in s. 373.2295 does not constitute a transfer or
new use under this section.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides for restrictions on the sale or transfer of
consumptive use permits or permitted quantities of
groundwater. Provides for exceptions.
