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The Legislature finds that many hospitals, physicians, and health care professionals that which provide services to trauma victims are not adequately compensated for such treatment. The Legislature also recognizes that the current verified trauma centers are providing such services without adequate reimbursement. Therefore, it is the intent of the Legislature to provide financial support to the current verified trauma centers and to establish a system of state-sponsored trauma centers as soon as feasibly possible. It is also the intent of the Legislature that this system of state-sponsored trauma centers be assisted financially based on the volume and
