A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to building designations at  
Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University;  
designating the School of Business and Industry  
building at Florida Agricultural and Mechanical

and Graphic Communication building at Florida  
Agricultural and Mechanical University as the

providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The School of Business and Industry  
building at Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University is  
designated as the "Sybil Collins Mobley Building."

Section 2. The School of Journalism and Graphic  
Communication building at Florida Agricultural and Mechanical  
University is designated as the "Thelma Thurston Gorham  
Building."

Section 3. Florida Agricultural and Mechanical  
University is authorized to erect suitable markers for these  
designations.

Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a  
law.
