1 A bill to be entitled 2 An act relating to the Division of Florida Land Sales, Condominiums, and Mobile Homes of the 3 4 Department of Business and Professional 5 Regulation; amending s. 718.501, F.S.; revising the time within which the division must respond 6 7 to and take action on complaints; providing an effective date. 8 9 10 WHEREAS, each condominium association pays \$4 per year per unit, to be directly deposited in the Florida Land Sales, 11 12 Condominium, and Mobile Homes Trust Fund, and WHEREAS, the annual fee that is paid by the condominium 13 14 associations is intended to fund the Department of Business and Professional Regulation's oversight of condominiums, land 15 sales, and mobile homes, and 16 17 WHEREAS, the Legislature and the Governor, in fiscal year 2003, transferred \$8.3 million from the Florida Land 18 19 Sales, Condominium, and Mobile Homes Trust Fund to general 20 revenue, NOW, THEREFORE, 21 22 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 23 Section 1. Paragraph (m) of subsection (1) of section 24 25 718.501, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 718.501 Powers and duties of Division of Florida Land 26 27 Sales, Condominiums, and Mobile Homes. --28 (1) The Division of Florida Land Sales, Condominiums, and Mobile Homes of the Department of Business and 29 30 Professional Regulation, referred to as the "division" in this part, in addition to other powers and duties prescribed by

chapter 498, has the power to enforce and ensure compliance with the provisions of this chapter and rules promulgated pursuant hereto relating to the development, construction, sale, lease, ownership, operation, and management of residential condominium units. In performing its duties, the division has the following powers and duties:

(m) When a complaint is made, the division shall conduct its inquiry with due regard to the interests of the affected parties. Within 15 30 days after receipt of a complaint, the division shall acknowledge the complaint in writing and notify the complainant whether the complaint is within the jurisdiction of the division and whether additional information is needed by the division from the complainant. The division shall conduct its investigation and shall, within 30 90 days after receipt of the original complaint or of timely requested additional information, take action upon the complaint. However, the failure to complete the investigation within 30 90 days does not prevent the division from continuing the investigation, accepting or considering evidence obtained or received after 30 90 days, or taking administrative action if reasonable cause exists to believe that a violation of this chapter or a rule of the division has occurred. If an investigation is not completed within the time limits established in this paragraph, the division shall, on a monthly basis, notify the complainant in writing of the status of the investigation. When reporting its action to the complainant, the division shall inform the complainant of any right to a hearing pursuant to ss. 120.569 and 120.57.
