16	(2) Children of military personnel who receive military										
17	orders to transfer to this state after a school year has begun										
18	shall be allowed to enroll in a school or program included in										
19	the public school choice options, listed in s. 1002.20(6)(a); in										
20	a public school that provides exceptional student education; or										
21	in a public school exceptional student program if they were										
22	enrolled in such a school or program in the state from which										
23	they transferred. A school's enrollment deadline shall not										
24	prevent such student from enrolling in a school or program										
25	pursuant to this subsection. However, if such student is unable										
26	to enroll in a school or program pursuant to this subsection due										
27	to space limitation, such student shall be listed for enrollment										
28	for the upcoming school term or school year.
