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(a) "Commission" means compensation accruing to a sales
representative for payment by a principal, the rate of which
compensation is expressed as a percentage of the dollar amount
of orders or sales.

(b) "Principal" means a person <u>or business which</u> who does not have a permanent or fixed place of business in this state and who:

Manufactures, produces, imports, or distributes a
 product <u>or service</u> for wholesale, except for fresh commodities.;

2. Contracts with a sales representative to solicit orders
for the product <u>or service.; and</u>

35 3. Compensates the sales representative, in whole or in36 part, by commission.

(c) "Sales representative" means a person <u>or business</u> <u>which</u> who contracts with a principal to solicit wholesale orders and who is compensated, in whole or in part, by commission, but does not include a person <u>or business which</u> who places orders for his or her own account for resale <u>or a person who is an</u> employee of the business.

(2) When a principal contracts with a sales representative to solicit wholesale orders within this state, the contract shall be in writing and shall set forth the method by which the commission is to be computed and paid. The principal shall provide the sales representative with a signed copy of the contract and shall obtain a signed receipt for the contract from the sales representative.

50 (3)(a) When the contract between a sales representative 51 and a principal is terminated and the contract was not reduced

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52 to writing, all commissions due shall be paid within 30 days 53 after <del>of</del> termination.

(b) In the event a principal fails to comply with the provisions of paragraph (a), the sales representative has a cause of action for damages equal to <u>triple</u> double the amount of commission found to be due. The prevailing party in any such action is entitled to an award of reasonable attorney's fees and court costs.

60 (4) This section does not apply to persons licensed
61 pursuant to chapter 475 who are performing services within the
62 scope of their license.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
